Do-Not-Call Notification

The Federal Communication Commission (FCC) and Federal Trade Commission (FTC) are now sharing responsibility for enforcing the National Do-Not-Call list. The FCC now requires all telecommunications carriers that provide Local Exchange Service to notify their subscribers of their rights as they relate to the Do-Not-Call rules. You have the right to give or revoke an objection to receiving telephone solicitations. Nebraska Telephone Assistance Program

In compliance with the Telecommunications Act of 1996 low income subscribers may qualify to receive reduced installation charges and reduced monthly charges for basic telephone service.

The "NTAP" program provides reduced connection charges to eligible telephone company subscribers. This reduction is 50% of connection charges or \$30.00, whichever is less. There is also deferred payment of connection charges without interest and customers who voluntarily participate in toll blocking may have deposits waived. The "NTAP" program provides reduced monthly charges to eligible telephone company subscribers. The reduced amount will be a credit of \$13.50 each month on basic telephone service. This credit applies only to the main line listed in the name of the eligible subscriber. You may submit the complete application to: Nebraska Public Service Commission Department, P.O. What is a V-Chip?

The V-Chip allows parents or other caregivers to block programming on their televisions that they don't want children to watch. Most television programs are now assigned a rating according to a system established by the television broadcast industry. The rating is encoded with the program before it airs, so that, using the remote control, parents can program the V-Chip to block viewing of shows with rating indicating that the program content may be inappropriate for children. Ratings systems currently in use are summarized below:

TV-Y: (Directed to All Children) found only in children's shows, means that the show is designed specifically for a very young audience, including children from ages 2-6.

TV-Y7: (Directed to Older Children) found only in children's shows, means that the show is most appropriate for children age 7 and up.

TV-Y7-FV: (Directed to Older Children-Fantasy Violence) means that fantasy violence may be more intense or more combative than other programming in the TV-Y7 category.

TV-G: (General Audience) means that the show is suitable for all ages but is not necessarily a children's show.

TV-PG: (Parental Guidance Suggested) means that parental guidance is recommended and that the program may be unsuitable for younger children. This rating may also include a V for violence, S for sexual situations, L for language, or D for suggestive dialogue.

TV-14: (Parents Strongly Cautioned) means that the show may be unsuitable for children under 14. V, S, L, or D may accompany a rating of TV-14.

TV-MA: (Mature Audience Only) means that the program is intended to be viewed by adults and may be unsuitable for children under 17. The program contains one or more of the following: V, S, L, or D.
