## Choose NetGuard

Netguard is a money saving maintenance program that allows you to have the ATC Communications trained technicians and support staff handle problems you may experience accessing the Internet while on our DSL, Cable or Fixed Wireless Internet Service.

With NetGuard, we install an ATC Communications supplied router which offers enhanced protection against unauthorized intrusion with a built-in firewall. Because of the continuous access to the Internet that DSL, Cable or Fixed Wireless Internet services allow, having a firewall is a prudent security measure. NetGuard also covers the replacement cost of the ATCJet.net supplied router as well as the replacement of the DSL or Cable modems used in our installations.

NetGuard is not a required part of ATC Communications broadband Internet service.

You are able to choose whether or not you want to be covered by this maintenance plan. If you choose not to sign up for the NetGuard, ATC Communications will only be responsible for the maintenance of our equipment up to demarcation points. The point of demarcation for a Fixed Wireless installation is the radio; for a DSL installation, it is the wall jack and for a Cable installation it is the cable wall jack.

## Pot O' Gold

### Ingredients

- 3-ounce box of lemon-flavor gelatin • 6 limes
- Sugar • 1 teaspoon of whipped cream

### Instructions

1. Line an 8-inch square baking dish with plastic wrap; leaving several inches of overhang on each side (this will make removing the gelatin easier). Combine a 3-ounce box of lemon-flavor gelatin and 1 cup of boiling water in a medium bowl, stirring until the gelatin is dissolved. Stir in 1 cup of cold water, and then pour the mixture into the baking dish. Cover the dish with plastic wrap and chill the gelatin for 4 hours or until firm, and then slice the gelatin into 1/2-inch cubes.
2. Cut off the top quarter of each of 6 limes, then, without cutting into the fruit, slice a thin layer of peel from the bottom of each one to help them stand upright. With a small knife, cut around the inside of each lime's rind to loosen the pulp, then spoon it out to make a shell.
3. Place a pinch of sugar and 1 teaspoon of whipped cream in the bottom of each shell, then fill each lime pot with gelatin gold. Makes 6.
