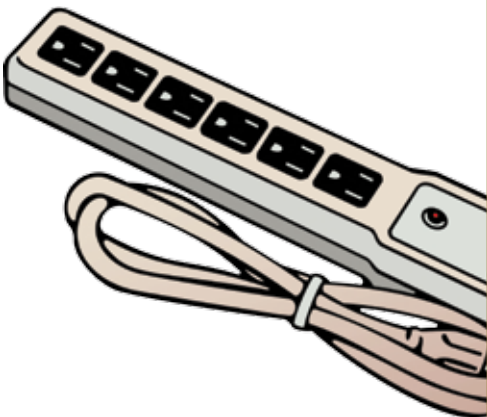
Power Strip or Surge Protector?

A power strip and a surge protector look similar, but they are two very different devices. If you're not careful when shopping, you may come home with the wrong one and not get the protection you expect.

What's the difference exactly?

The power strip is a device that allows you to plug multiple electronics into one wall socket. A surge protector acts as a power strip while also protecting your computer or other electronics from a power surge (a significant increase in electrical voltage).

You should definitely use a surge protector with your computer, since it's filled with voltage-sensitive components that a power surge could easily damage. At the least, this damage will shorten the life of your computer. In a worst-case scenario, it could wipe out all of your saved data or destroy your system. Computers are expensive items, and the data they hold is often irreplaceable, so it just makes sense to invest in a quality surge protector. It's also a good idea to use surge protectors for other high end electronic equipment, such as entertainment center components.
